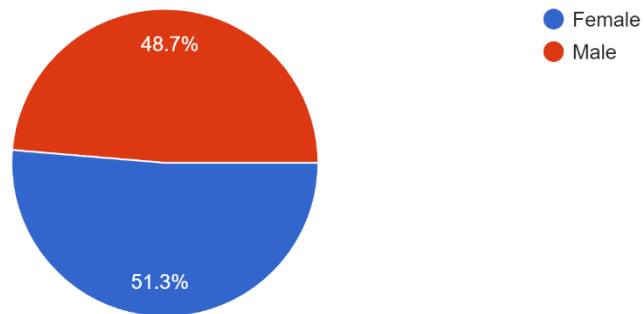

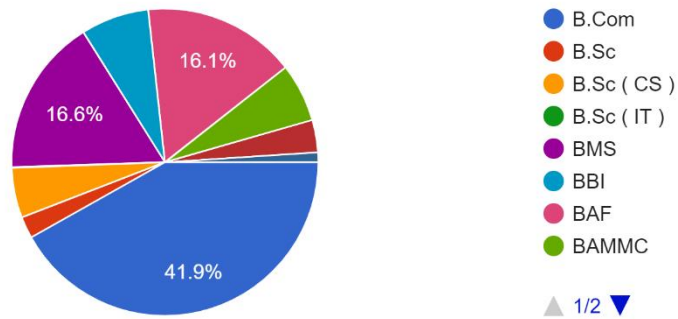

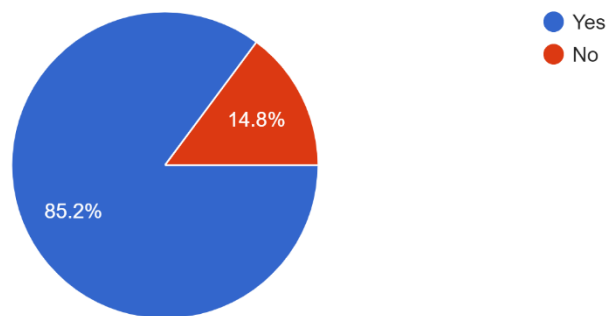
### Which degree are you pursuing ?

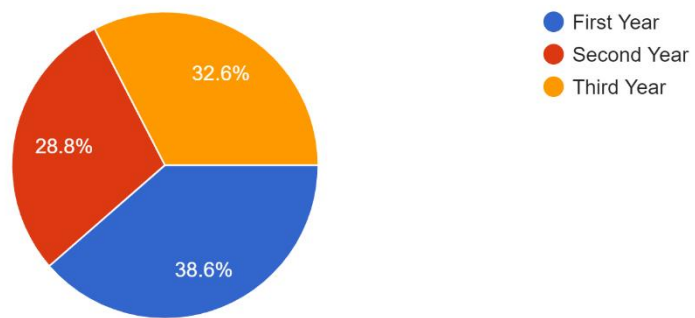
### Are you aware of the Vision & Mission of the Institution? Are they Followed ?

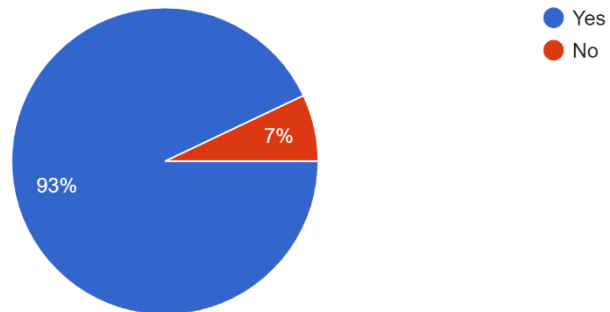

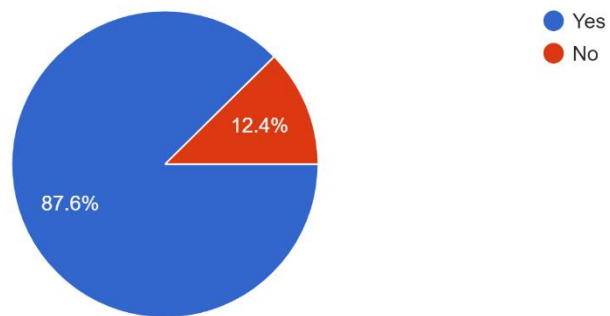
Did the teachers share with you teaching Plan in class?

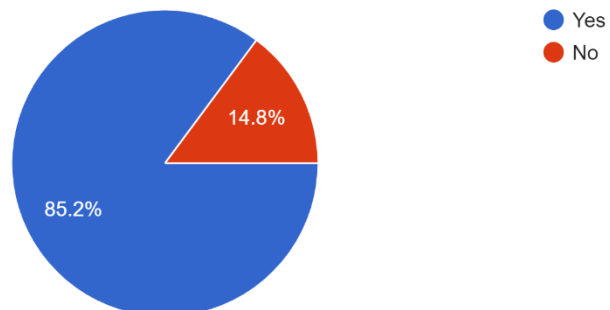
Does College arrange Induction Program?

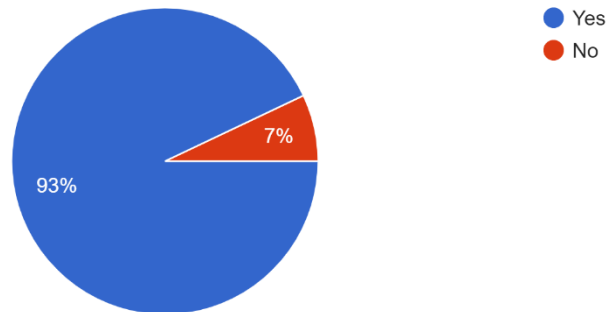

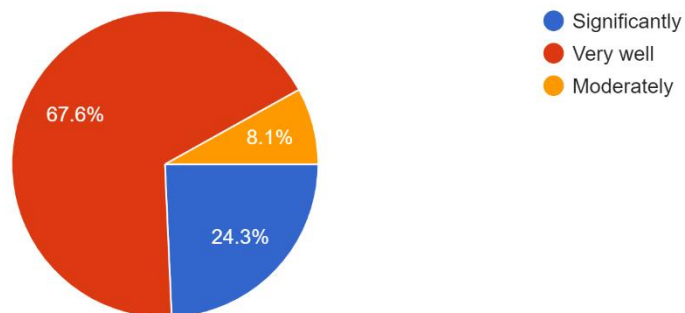
Did the teachers share with you teaching Plan in class?

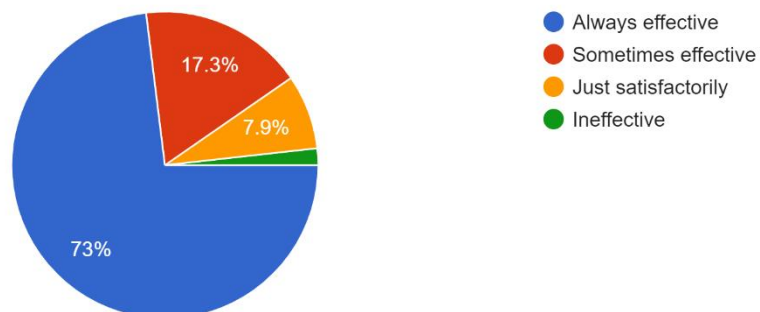
How well did the teachers prepare for the online classes?

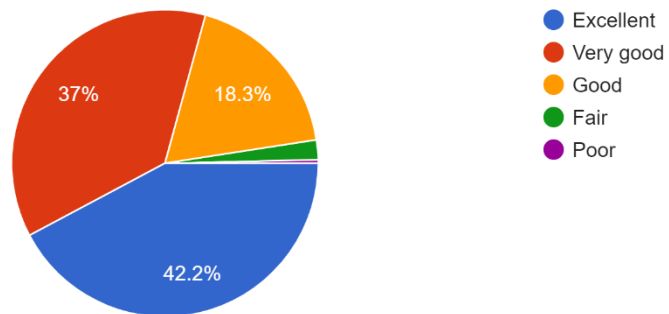
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

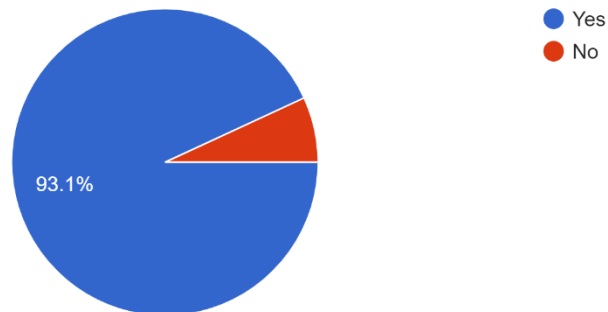
The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

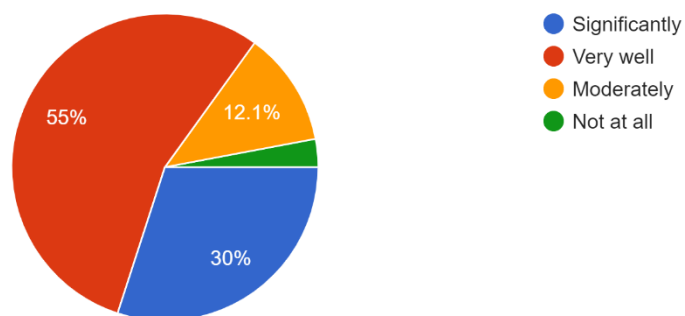
Do you think that teaching methods adopted by the teachers help in attaining objectives of the programme?

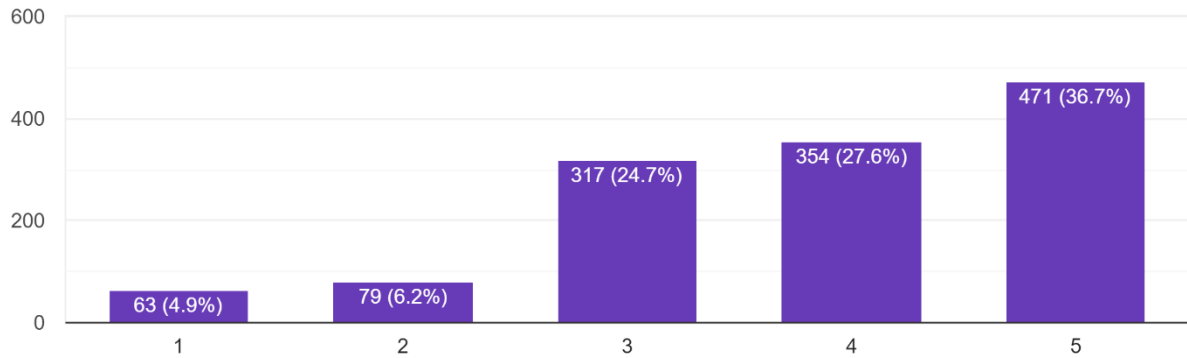
The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth during this Pandemic.

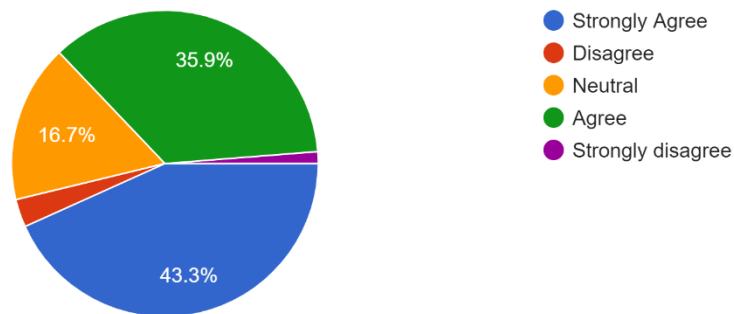

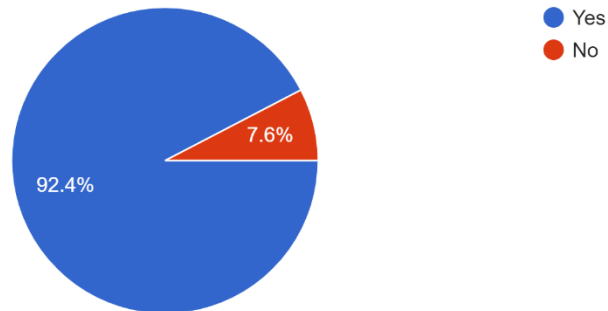

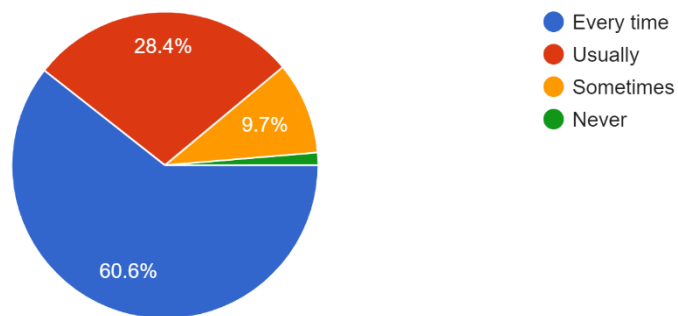

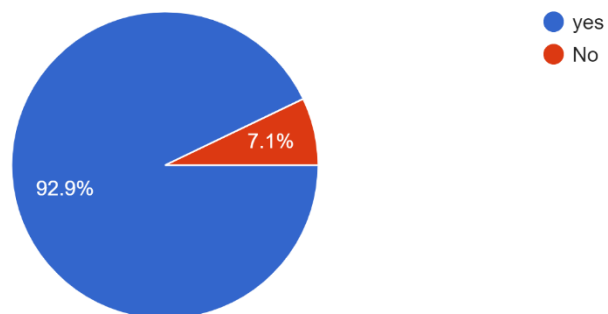
The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

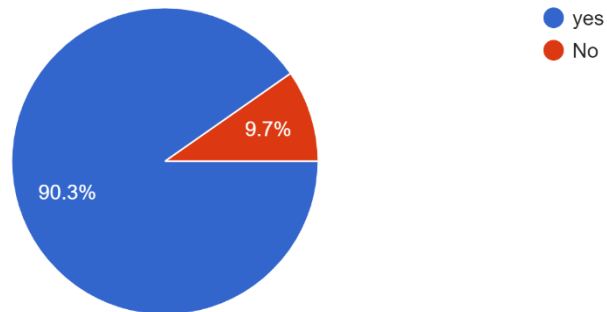

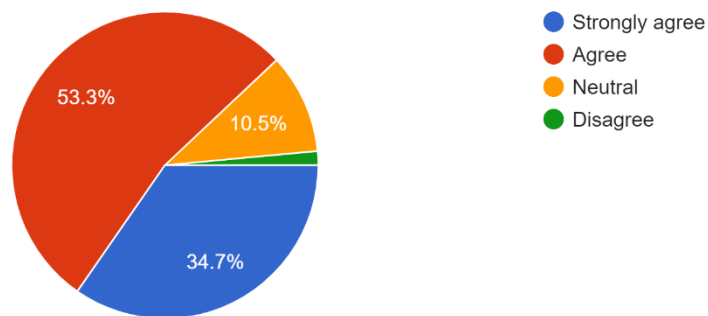
Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

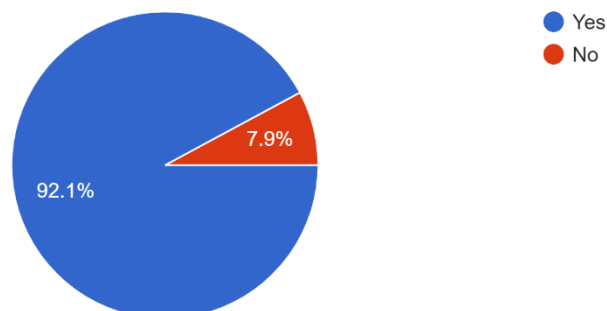

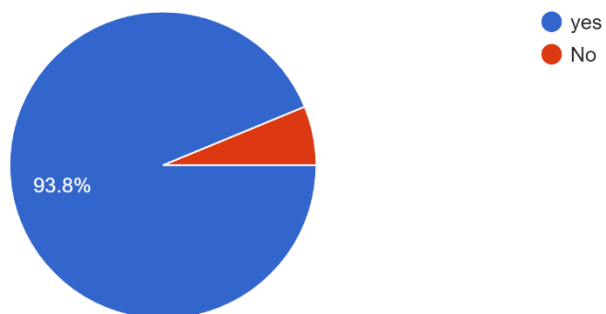

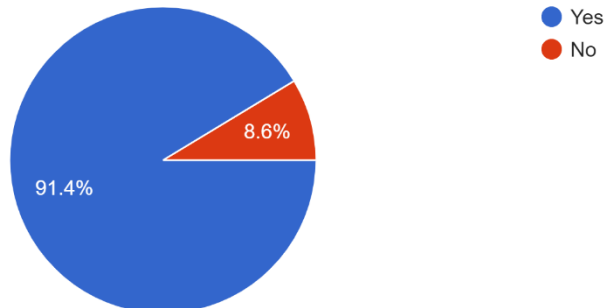
Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

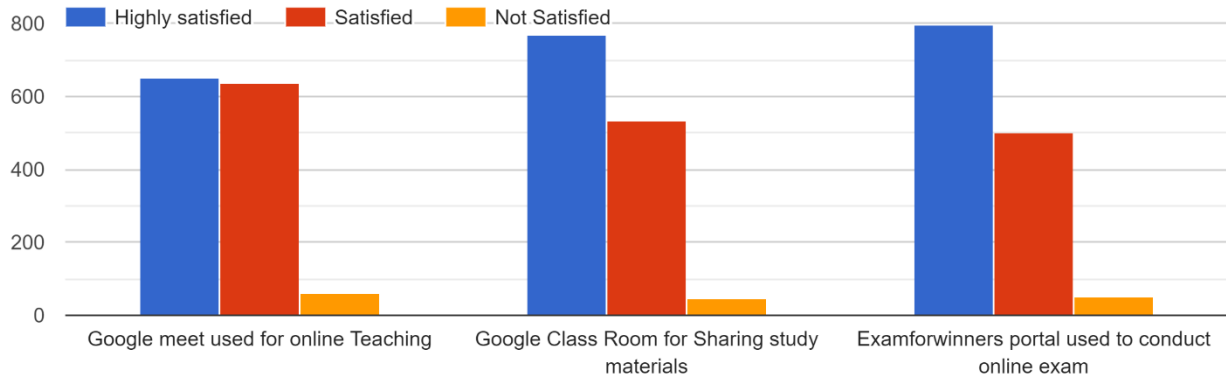

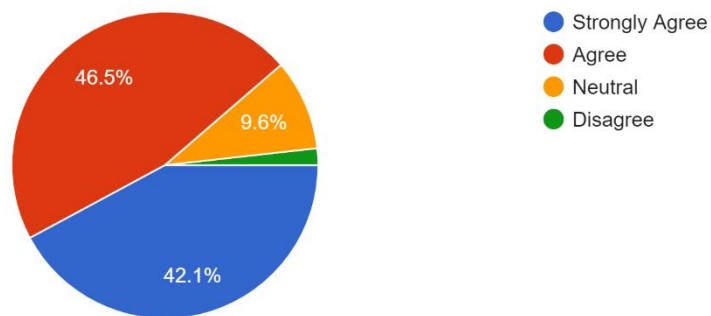


How would you rate your experience on e-tools used by the Institution for online teaching, learning & evaluation Process?

## Student Satisfaction Survey 2021–2022

The online teaching-learning assessment and other general issues pertaining to the college and the facilities provided are the main areas of attention of the Student Satisfaction Survey for the academic year 2021–2022. Based on the questions created by the college's IQAC, the replies from the students were gathered and analysed.

The survey sought student feedback on the curriculum, the completion of the course syllabus, the teachers' preparedness, the staff members' attitudes, the fairness and transparency of internal evaluations, extracurricular and co-curricular activities, and the overall impression of the college. The analysis was based on a survey that 1350 students completed.

According on the data gathered, the following analysis was carried out:

1. To familiarise first-year students with the courses, infrastructure, library resources, extension activities, examination and its rules, and placement services offered by the college, the institution organises an Induction programme every academic year. 1183 students have confirmed this information.
2. Vision and mission offers a solid foundation that can withstand internal changes. 1150 students, were determined to be aware of the institution's proper adherence to its vision and mission.
3. In order to connect new lessons with past sessions, faculties share their lesson plans with students in advance. A total of 1255 students, agreed the same.
4. In order to make online instruction more efficient and engaging, teachers have used contemporary teaching tools. All 100% of the students agreed that the faculty had employed ICT in their teaching.
5. Communication is both expressive and receptive, and 1326 students agreed that teachers had effectively interacted with their students.
6. To ensure the students' comprehensive growth, 1345 of the students responded that faculties had adopted various inventive approaches to spread knowledge and to keep teaching-learning interesting.

7. In order to reach every student, faculty employ a variety of instructional techniques, 1257 of the students are happy with the way the faculty members are engaging the students to obtain the objectives of the programme.
8. Out of 1350 students 1310 of them agreed that the college's teaching and mentoring methods fairly contribute to their development on the cognitive, emotional, and social levels.
9. The institution makes an attempt to instill moral values, environmental awareness, and value-based social responsibility through extension programmes like NSS, DLLE, NCC, ECO CLUB, and WDC. The majority of the students, 3221 agreed the same.
10. To increase students' competency level, the college organises intra- and intercollegiate competitions, seminars, workshops, certificate programmes, and sports events that give them numerous learning and development opportunities. 1319 of the students believe that the college adopts various strategies for the effective delivery.
11. Out of 1350 students, 1247 of them agreed that teachers inform them about their competences, course outcomes, and programme outcomes.
12. Knowledge retention leads to self-actualization. To ensure the same, teachers illustrate concepts with examples and applications. 1332 of the students firmly agreed that the institution follows the same procedures.
13. To encourage and involve students in learning process and to help them attain their highest levels of accomplishment, the college adopted mentoring system. 1254 students agreed for the same.
14. The importance of feedback in enhancing students' educational experiences cannot be overstated. Teachers can use the knowledge from effective feedback to create improved learning environments, 1330 of the students agreed that the institution collects feedback for continuous quality improvement in teaching learning process.
15. The goal of the entire educational process is to make learning more student-centric. The college makes all of its courses more interactive and collaborative by putting a strong emphasis on specific learning outcomes, 1244 of the students accepted the same.

16. Knowing about students' strengths and weaknesses will make the planning more effective. For this, the institution established a student-friendly strategy to determine students' strengths and shortcomings through regular class participation, written evaluations, quizzes, and presentations. Teachers help students to overcome their weaknesses by identifying them and providing assistance and inspiration. 1219 students responded favourably.

17. Students who participate in extracurricular activities succeed both personally and academically. To do this, the institution plans a number of events, and faculty members encourage students for participation and 1266 students think that institution inspired them to discover their skills and abilities.

18. Through the delivery of seminars, workshops, and certificate courses, the institution is making an effort to instill soft skills, life skills, and employability skills among students to prepare them for the competitive world and 1194 students agreed for the same.

19. The institution used a variety of e-tools to enhance the quality of the online teaching and learning process. 1291 of students provided good feedback on the e-tools used by the faculty members in online teaching, learning and evaluation process.

20. The dedicated faculty members of the institution adopted qualitative online teaching learning approach to enhance and impart quality education. 1326 students have given positive response.
