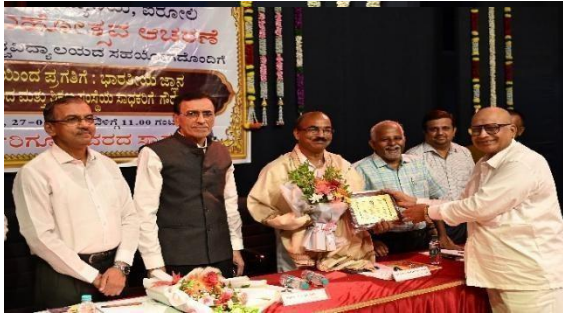
Silver Jubilee Celebration

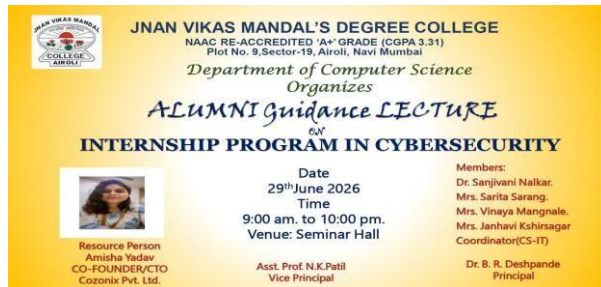
